What we do

Moses Charity Organization MCO is a Zambia Non-Profit making organization founded in 2021 in the great city of Lusaka and registered with Ministry of Community Development and Social Welfare under The Non-Governmental Organizations Act (Act No. 16 of 2009) of the laws of Zambia. The organization was established with the main objectives to provide a holistic transformation of young people and disadvantaged communities by offering training, empowerment and exposure to life-changing innovations.

Our work remains focused on the most vulnerable children living in Magoye and Pemba district, Southern province of Zambia and we continue to maintain the personal community involvement that has become the trademark of MCO. The unique selection/assessment process for children to join our programmes ensures we continue to select those children who are the poorest of the poor and at the lowest levels of the community. Last year we supported approximately 150 children and their families through our different programmes, 50 of which are supported through child sponsorship.

Pemba district is the rural district of southern province with many people living in poverty with no proper water and sanitation. There is widespread poverty with approximately 90% of the population earning less than one US dollar per day.

VISSION

Communities where children and their care givers are empowered to improve their own livelihood through appropriate and affordable alternatives.

MISSION

To restore hope among vulnerable children and communities that have been affected by poverty, abuse, violence, disease and other natural calamities.

Our Achievements

This year we achieved a significant milestone as we said goodbye to 2022.

We continued to consolidate our work on improving the lives of those living in Pemba district. Because of us, more children are receiving education materials, Nutrition support to vulnerable children, Food relief programs e.tc

Project Highlights - Education

In 2022, our education programme has continued to expand in size as the organization continue supporting school going children support them with school materials such as books, pens, pencils and other school material.



Project Highlights - Health

With the support of our volunteers work team, 2022 saw the launch of Nutrition project in Magoye with over 50 people in attendance. The project now runs regular trainings for community members on topics such as Health, nutrition, hygiene and sanitation amongst others to pregnant and breastfeeding mothers. Same year we sponsored 4 children with nutritional support who were suffering from malnutrition problem and also through our partners our organization paid the medical bills to one of our disabled girl in Pemba district.



Project Highlights – Children with Special Needs

As a result of generous fundraising efforts, the organization managed to lobby for 2 wheelchairs for our disabled girls in Pemba district.



Project Highlights – Food Relief Distribution

The hunger situation in Zambia according to 2022 Global Hunger Index, Zambia ranks **108th** out of the 121 countries with sufficient data to calculate 2022 GHI scores. With a score of **29.3%**, Zambia has a level of hunger that is **serious**.

The current vulnerability in Zambia has been driven by a high incidence of poverty, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, macroeconomic instability, and exposure to climatic shocks. This has resulted in an increase in food insecurity in the analyzed districts primarily driven by these shocks such as prolonged dry spells, flooding, reduced livelihood opportunities due to restrictions, pests and diseases, and high input and food prices.

2022 Moses Charity Organization held a successful Food Relief Distribution in two wards namely Kaikili and Maambo respectively of Pemba district southern province of Zambia.

The Food Relief Distribution was witnessed by the district commissioner of Pemba district Mr. Oby Habeezu, two councilors from Maambo and Kasikili wards respectively and other invited guests.

Thanks to our partners, we were able to successfully hold 7 days food relief distributions during the month of November 2022. Over 50 families received mealie meal, beans, kapenta and cooking oil to make sure that their children, including the many Orphans, disabled and Vulnerable Children these families have taken in, were still fed despite having no source of income.



Project Highlights – Feeding Program

This is the program we help vulnerable children with food pack such as maize, mealie meals and cooking food them.

We have been running this program since organization was registered and this program it is runs on monthly basis whenever we have receive donations from our well-wishers and from membership subscription fees.

In 2022 we run this program twice for school going vulnerable children in Pemba.



Project Highlights – Help A Child

Help A Child Project is the program were we helped vulnerable children with school materials, shoes, clothes and blankets. We run this project at Maambo Primary School and Maofa Community School in Pemba district southern province of Zambia.



Project Highlights – Other Activities

Moses charity Organization under environmental protection program did a community sensitization program tree plant program and dangers of cutting of trees to the environment and also 2022 we also participated on mental health awareness in Lusaka Zambia.

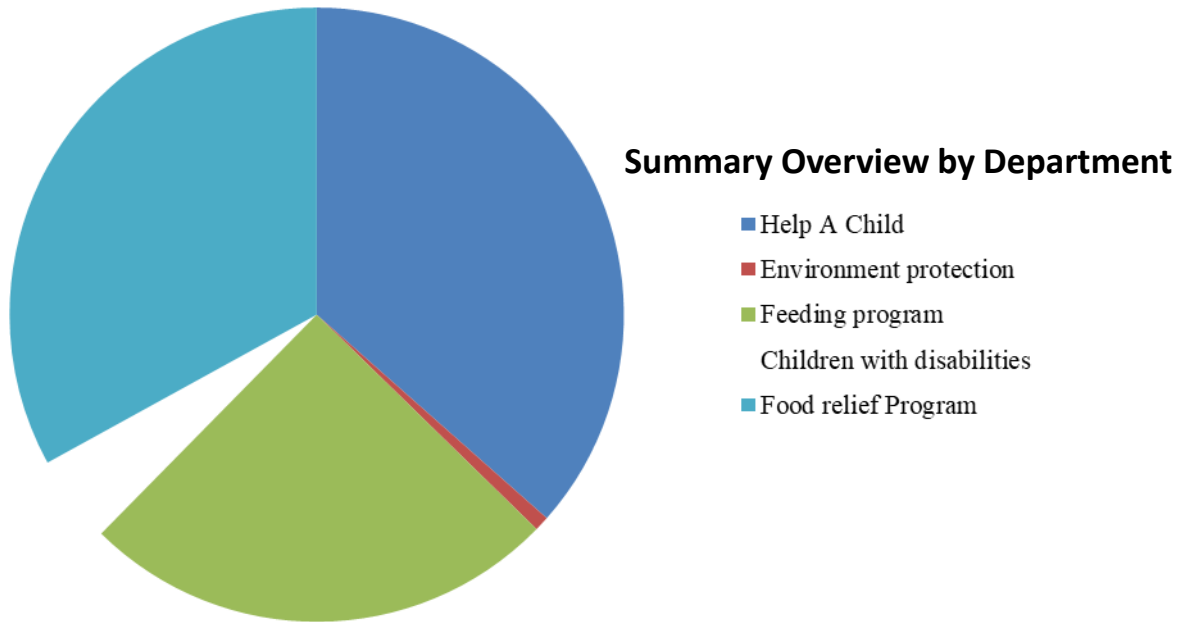
